And, here are the activities in preparation for our ZOOM. Have fun making, and doing, and hopefully we can show each other what we have done!

For dinner, we suggest tomato soup – after all, the story is about crossing the Red Sea!!

ACTIVITIES:

- Make a 'staff' like Moses had
- Create a 'burning bush' picture
- Take a break with an edible snack that parts the Red Sea (hint that's the next part of the story!) Please take a picture of your snack and we can 'screen-share'.
- Make a bookmark the people were led by God's 'pillar of cloud by day, and pillar of fire by night'. (hint that's also in the next part of the story)
- Do a wordsearch (this one is for the readers including adults!)
- Find your way through a maze
- Discover the secret message in the colouring puzzle

When we ZOOM, we will pause **another craft** that we will all do at the same time, and then talk about together.

Make a 'STAFF' like Moses had!

A staff is a tool that shepherds use to help herd the sheep. A hook to catch straying sheep and a rod end to help the shepherd walk on rocky ground. Moses was a shepherd who carried a staff.

Using items at home, make a staff to be like Moses. It can be made of Lego, a cardboard roll or stick that you find outside.

Colour or decorate it as you want!

Options:

Draw a bush, and colour it brightly as if it is both growing and on fire (what colours would you use?)

Recipe 1 – Parting the Red Sea Bread

You will need 1 slice of bread per person


Cover with peanut butter, wow butter, almond spread or hazelnut spread On the sides of your bread use strawberry, raspberry, grape or blueberry jam to make a 'red sea water.

Down the middle of your bread, sprinkle brown or white sugar and if you like to make 'sand'.

(You can sprinkle the sugar with cinnamon).

Recipe 2 – Parting the Red Sea Graham Crackers


You will need one cracker per person and some coloured icing Cover both edges of the graham cracker with blue or red icing Option: Add some gold fish on the icing






