



DIY GALAXY PLAYDOUGH

What You Need – Galaxy Playdough

|-------------------------|----------------|
| Flour | Blue glitter |
| Salt | Pink glitter |
| Cream of tater | Black glitter |
| Vegetable oil | Silver glitter |
| Black gel food coloring | |

1. Add 1 cup of flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ a cup of salt, a tablespoon of cream of tartar, and a tablespoon of vegetable oil to a small bowl.
2. Add several squirts of black food coloring. You will probably have to add about twice as much dye as you think you need to get a true black color.
3. Mix in a tablespoon of black glitter.
4. Heat $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cup of water until boiling. Pour it into the bowl along with the flour mixture.
5. Stir with a fork, then as the water cools, mix it the rest of the way with your hands. The black coloring won't mix in completely until you knead the dough for a while.
6. When the dough is completely cool, it's time to turn it into a galaxy!
7. Form the dough into a ball. Sprinkle the dough with stripes of blue and pink glitter. Mix the glitter into the dough, but not all the way.
8. Sprinkle the entire ball gently with the silver glitter to make stars.
