Esther and Emmett:

Esther: I'm thankful for friends who are like the autumn leaves!

Emmett: You have friends who are like the autumn leaves...do they fall out of tress a lot?

Esther: No, but like the autumn leaves, somedays those friends show me something amazing about God. Just when I think it's 'just another day' does something nice and the day come alive... like the new colours of the leaves.
