## Esther and Emmett – Oct 17, 2021

Emmett: Hi Esther.

Esther: Hi Emmett. What are you up to?

Emmett: I'm imagining Jesus flying on an airplane!

Esther: Oh Emmett, they didn't have airplanes in Jesus' time.

Emmett: Well that's good, because Jesus would always have been stuck in the middle seat!

Esther: Why do you think that Jesus would be in the middle seat?

Emmett: Because his disciples wanted the seat by the window and the seat on the aisle. I don't blame them., I think those are the better seats.

Esther: Why are you thinking about Jesus and airplanes?

Esther: I don't think they were talking about being on an airplane!

Emmett: It sounded like that to me. Two of the disciples, James and John – they were brothers, you know – they told Jesus they wanted him to do something for them.

Esther: Oh, now I know what story you've been reading in the Bible!

Emmett: They said," Allow us to sit, one at your hand and one at your left, in your glory." I thought it was kind of funny to say "in your glory"...then I thought that maybe 'glory' was the name of an airplane.

Esther: Oh Emmett!

Emmett: I know...sometimes I'm so smart I even amaze myself.

Esther: 'Glory' wasn't the name of an airplane.

Emmett: It wasn't?

Emmett: It makes it a lot easier to pass the food to one another!

Esther: That's because those people are sitting close to you. In fact, they are the closest people to you at the table.

Emmett: So James and John wanted to sit close to Jesus when they were eating?

Esther: Yes, because in that society, if someone important invited people to a meal, the person hosting the dinner was supposed to seat next to themselves the people they thought were the most important people.

Emmett: Ohhhhh...! So James and John wanted a promotion!

Esther: They wanted Jesus to say they were the most important disciples.

Emmett: That's why the story in the Bible says that the other disciples got angry at James and John – who were brothers, you know.

Esther: Yes, they were upset, maybe because each of them wanted to sit on Jesus' left or right-hand side.

Emmett: They were going to need a really wide plane!

Esther: Jesus told them not to be worried about who was most important. He said that everyone is important to God.

Emmett: I really like Jesus!

Esther: Jesus said God didn't want them competing for God's love... God wanted them to share God's love...with everyone....so then everyone would know that they were

important to God.

Emmett: So...it wouldn't matter where anyone sat on the plane, just as long as everyone got to fly in the glory plane?
